## Rules and Regulations

- 1. Rules: The rules of this tournament shall remain unchanged. Any violation of these rules shall be deemed grounds for disqualification and the entrant will forfeit his/her/their entry fee. Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively up to the tournament rules committee. Precedence takes priority over all unwritten rules. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final.
- 2. Safety: All entrants must wear a chest-type life preserver, fastened, whenever the combustion engine is in operation. Safe boating must be observed at all times. NO ALCOHOLIC beverages shall be allowed in tournament boats, nor will drunkenness be tolerated at either pre-tournament meeting, on tournament waters, or at tournament weigh ins. ABSOLUTLEY no fishing while the big motor is in gear.
- 3. Sportsmanship: Each entrant is expected to have high standards of fairness, courtesy, safety, and conservation. Any extreme violation of sportsmanship will be grounds for disqualification from all future Waupaca Bass Club events.
- 4. Fishing Boundaries: Any water accessible from the Wolf River System without going through a dam is available for fishing. The weigh in area is for competitors and weigh in officials ONLY. NO horseplay will be tolerated.
- 5. Scoring: (5) Five fish limit. The tournament committee will handle, bump and weigh all fish. Their decisions on bumping or live fish determination shall be final. All fish will be measured from the tip of the snout (mouth closed) to the tip of the tail. All fish to be weighed in must be fourteen (14) inches. Short fish will be eliminated as well as the largest fish of current days bag. Scoring will be conducted on electronic scales. It is prohibited to offer or accept fish from anyone. Scoring will be awarded to the weight of catch, LIVE or DEAD. Penalties for dead fish is 1/4 pound per fish. You must be checked in to designated area by announced time or be disqualified. No excuses, LATE IS LATE

- 6. Fishing Methods: Only artificial lures may be used with the exception of pork rind. Only one rod and reel may be used at one time by each contestant. Trolling is prohibited. All fish must be caught and landed live and in a sporting manner from inside the tournament boat. A maximum of five (5) fish may be brought to the scales.
- 7. Breakdown: Should a tournament craft become inoperable, one member of the team may bring catch to the scales as long as they are picked up by another tournament boat. Both members of the second craft must verify the catches of the disabled crafts anglers and sign their weigh in slip. Each party's fish must be kept separate.
- 8. Registration: All entrants (at least 1 member of each team) must register in person at the team meeting. Pre-tournament meetings are mandatory for all teams unless the tournament director has been notified and has approved of the teams absence. Failure to comply will result in disqualification and forfeiting their entry fee. Each team must consist of 2 members, no one can fish alone.
- 9. Boats and Equipment: All contestants will also obey all U.S Coast Guard boating regulations, and all boats must confirm to all BIA ratings. All boats are required to have proper state registration and meet all Coast Guard and state safety requirements. In addition, all boats must have a functional live well, or properly aerated container. NO TEAM will be allowed to fish without the live well container checked by the tournament official.
- 10. Protests: Protests may be submitted to the tournament director within thirty (30) minutes of the official (Flight) weigh in time. Protest will be heard by the tournament committee upon filing a written complaint along with \$50.00, which is refundable if protest is upheld. If not the \$50.00 will not be returned. All money is held until a decision is made. All contestants are subject to polygraph prior to receiving checks if deemed necessary.
- 11. Misc: Any team receiving a citation from any law enforcement agency while on tournament waters and during tournament hours will forfeit that days catch and will receive a zero (0).
